Despite being sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 5000/- and default imprisonment of 10 days, the accused has not complied with the order and has been absconding since the date of sentence.

Accordingly, T.I. Khajuri is directed to take necessary steps to secure the presence of the accused and also to trace and file the fresh address of the accused on the NDOH.
