Today is fixed for hearing of the application u/s 483 BNSS.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the accused/petitioners viz, Sk. Emarul Ali, Sk. Ajahar, Sk. Raju and Sk. Mustak Ali is present and submits that no application for bail either U/S 482 BNS or U/S 483 BNS has been preferred, rejected or pending before any higher forum in respect of the present accused/petitioners and to that effect an affidavit has been filed.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the accused/petitioners submits that :-

- 1) His clients are in custody since 04.05.2026;
- 2) They have been falsely implicated in this case;
- 3) Investigation has fairly proceeded;
- 4) Accused/petitioners were not taken into P.C;
- 5) They were named in the FIR;
- 6) No T.I. parade has been conducted till date;
- 7) Another co accused has been enlarged on bail vide order No.3 dated 19.05.2026 passed in CMC No. 244/26.

Contending thus he prayed for enlarging his clients on bail.

Ld. P.P in-charge raises objection against the prayer for bail citing the materials collected in the CD.

Perused the materials on record and the CD.

Heard both sides. Considered.

Considering the C.D and all other materials on record, I find that accused/petitioners are in custody for a considerable period of time. Injury report reveal physical assault by unknown people. Specific role of the accused/petitioners cannot be gathered from the materials collected during investigation. Investigation has fairly proceeded. No prayer for further custodial interrogation of the accused/petitioners have been submitted by I.O. In the circumstances, I do not think further detention is required for custodial interrogation of the accused/petitioners. Hence, the prayer for bail is allowed.

Accordingly, accused/petitioners Sk. Emarul Ali, Sk. Ajahar, Sk. Raju and Sk. Mustak Ali may find bail furnishing bail bond of Rs. 4,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 2,000/- each, one of which must be an Advocate surety, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. A.C.J.M Uluberia, on condition that the accused/petitioners shall meet the I.O. once in a week till completion of investigation.

Thus the Criminal Misc. Case no.268/2026 is disposed.
