ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

Perused the record. Heard Shri. A. M. Tarde, learned counsel for the applicants and Shri Pratapsingh Parihar, learned counsel for the respondent No.3 insurance company.

2. The terms of the compromise at Exh.20 are filed along with report of mediation at Exh.18. It shows that the applicants and respondent No.3 insurance company have settled the matter. The agreed compensation amount is Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lac). I have verified the terms of the settlement from the applicants, their learned counsel and the learned counsel for respondent No.3. It also seen that applicants do not desire to proceed against the respondent Nos.1 and 2.

3. Considering the facts and the claim of the applicants, the settlement arrived at is as per law. Therefore, I pass the following order.

ORDER

1. The petition is disposed off against respondent Nos.1 and 2.
2. The petition is disposed as settled against respondent No.3 for the full and final compensation amount of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lac) to the applicants jointly.
