ORDER:

1. File put up before me being duty Judge during threat of spreading COVID-19. Vide this applicant, accused-applicant named above has sought regular bail under section 439 of Cr.P.C. in the above noted FIR.
2. It has been averred in the application and argued by the learned counsel for accused/applicant that applicant has been falsely implicated in this case and is totally innocent and preliminary the case was registered against unknown person and the police arrested the accused-applicant in this case on 25.05.2020 and since then the applicant is in custody. Nothing was recovered from the accused-applicant and no useful purpose will be served by detaining the applicant behind the bars. With these submission, he prayed to release the accused-applicant on regular bail.
3. Per contra, ld. Addl. P.P. for State present in the court, opposed the bail application.

4. Rival contentions of both the sides have been heard and case file perused with due care and circumspection.

5. Perusal of police record shows that as per complainant Rupinderjit Singh, on 24.06.2019, when he was going on his motorcycle to bring his wife Jaswinder Kaur from village Meemsa, five unknown persons while riding a Car, intercepted his way and gave beating to him with deadly weapons. The FIR was registered against unknown persons and later on the accused-applicant was arrested along with co-accused and offence U/s.379-B, 201 and 109 IPC have been added later on. Applicant is in custody since 25.05.2020. As per prosecution, accused-applicant is not involved in any other case. Moreover, co-accused have already been granted concession of bail. As such no useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant behind the bars. Thus, under the given set of circumstances, the present application for bail stands ***allowed*** and applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount with the following condition

1. That he will appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing during trial without fail;
2. That he will not leave the Country without prior permission of the Court.

Since, there is threat of spreading COVID-19 in the state, therefore, accused-applicant is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- before the concerned Jail Superintendent who shall send the copies of the same to the court concerned. The accused-applicant is further also directed to furnish his regular bail bonds as and when the courts

starts functioning regularly. Police record be returned. Bail application file be sent to the concerned court.
