Today is fixed for hearing of the application u/s 483 BNSS.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the accused/petitioner viz, Sahabul Mallick is present and submits that no application for bail either U/S 482 BNS or U/S 483 BNS has been preferred, rejected or pending before any higher forum in respect of the present accused/petitioner and to that effect an affidavit has been filed.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the accused/petitioner submits that :-

- 1) His client is in custody since 02.05.2026;
- 2) He has been falsely implicated in this case;
- 3) Investigation has fairly proceeded;
- 4) Dispute is pending between the parties since long;
- 5) Other criminal cases are pending.

Contending thus he prayed for enlarging his client on bail.

Ld. P.P in-charge raises objection against the prayer for bail citing the materials collected in the CD.

Perused the materials on record and the CD.

Heard both sides. Considered.

Considering the C.D and all other materials on record, I find that accused/petitioner is in custody for a considerable period of time. Investigation has fairly proceeded. Pendency other cases between the parties has been noted during such investigation. Statement of victim recorded u/s 183 of BNSS does not tally with her version as can be gathered from the written complaint. No significant development in investigation has been recorded in CD after the accused was arrested. In the circumstances, I do not think further detention of accused/petitioner is not necessary. Hence, the prayer for bail is allowed

Accordingly, accused/petitioner viz, Sahabul Mallick may find bail furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 4,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 2,000/- each, one of which must be an advocate surety, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. A.C.J.M Uluberia, on condition that he shall meet the I.O. once in a week till completion of investigation.

Thus the Criminal Misc. Case no.254/2026 is disposed.
