Today is fixed for hearing of the application u/s 483 BNSS.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the accused/petitioner viz, Surajit Khara @ Khanra is present and submits that no application for bail either U/S 482 BNS or U/S 483 BNS has been preferred, rejected or pending before any higher forum in respect of the present accused/petitioner and to that effect an affidavit has been filed.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the accused/petitioner submits that :-

- 1) His client is in custody since 19.05.2026;
- 2) He has been falsely implicated in this case;
- 3) Investigation has fairly proceeded;
- 4) Another accused named in the FIR has been enlarged on bail by the Ld. A.C.J.M. Uluberia vide order dated 22.05.2022;
- 5) Allegations labelled against the accused are vague and stereo typical in nature.

Contending thus he prayed for enlarging his client on bail.

Ld. P.P in-charge raises objection against the prayer for bail citing the materials collected in the CD.

Perused the materials on record and the CD.

Heard both sides. Considered.

Considering the C.D and all other materials on record, I find that accused/petitioner is in custody for a considerable period of time. Investigation has fairly proceeded. Accused/petitioner was not taken into P.C. Nothing was recovered from him. Statement of victim u/s 183 of BNSS has not been recorded. Torn wearing apparels have not been seized. No significant developed in investigation has been recorded in CD after 22.05.2026. In the circumstances, I do not think further detention of accused/petitioner is not necessary. Hence, the prayer for bail is allowed

Accordingly, accused/petitioner viz, Surajit Khara @ Khanra may find bail furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 4,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 2,000/- each, one of which must be an advocate surety, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. A.C.J.M Uluberia, on condition that the accused/petitioner shall meet the I.O. once in a week till completion of investigation.

Thus the Criminal Misc. Case no.275/2026 is disposed.
