Order

1. Heard on bail application of applicant/accused Sanjeev Sharma @ Happy, who is in custody for commission of offences u/s 318(2) & 316(2) of BNS, PS City, Phagwara.

2. Counsel for the applicant/accused has argued that the accused/ applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. The accused/applicant has not committed any offence. The applicant/accused is in judicial custody since 20.06.2025 and no useful purpose be served by keeping him behind the bar as nothing is recovered from her. The accused/applicant undertake to abide by all the terms and conditions as imposed by the Court. Lastly, prayed for allowing the bail application.

3. On the other hand Ld.APP for the State opposed the bail application submitting that the offence complained of is serious in nature and bail application may be dismissed.

4. I have heard the contentions of Ld. counsel for the accused/applicant as well as Ld. APP for the State. Statement of ASI Jaswant Singh perused who stated that as per record, no bail application of accused Sanjeev Sharma @ Happy is pending or decided in this FIR by any court of law. Perusal of the remand papers reveal that accused/applicant is in custody since the date of his arrest. Conclusion of trial will take sufficient time. Therefore no useful purpose will be served by detaining accused/applicant in custody except having a burden on the state exchequer. As such, accused is entitled to concession of bail. Hence, the applicant/accused Sanjeev Sharma @ Happy is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing by him bail bonds in the sum of Rs.40,000/- along with one surety in the like amount subject to following conditions:-

- 1 The accused shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the court.
- 2 He will not tamper with the evidence in any manner.
- 3 Accused and surety shall be under obligation to intimate to the court, if there is any change in their addresses.
- 4 The accused shall be responsible to appear to this court on each every date of hearing unless otherwise directed.

Application disposed off accordingly. Bail bonds not furnished.
