

Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab

This is a bail application filed U/s 482 of B.N.S.S for grant of anticipatory bail, filed on behalf of applicant Jagjit Kaur, in FIR no. 09 dated 29.01.2025, U/S 406, 420, 120-B of IPC, P.S Sirhind.

During the course of arguments, Ld. Counsel for complainant Sh. PC Joshi Advocate has suffered statement that matter be referred to the mediation centre for 05.03.2025.

On the other Ld. Counsel for applicant has raised no objection if matter be referred to mediation.

Heard. In view of the request made by Ld. Counsel for the parties, it is desired that before deciding this anticipatory bail application, the case of bail applicant be referred for mediation, so that matter can be amicably resolved between the parties. Moreover, Ld. Public Prosecutor for the State has raised no objection in referring the matter to mediation centre. Thus in order to facilitate the applicant/accused to attend mediation, this court deems it fit to grant umbrella of interim anticipatory bail to the bail applicant for only purpose of mediation, otherwise applicant/accused shall not claim any right for taking benefits of anticipatory bail. Bail application shall be decided exclusively on merits, if mediation fails. Applicant/accused is directed to appear before the mediation centre on 05.03.2025. I.O of this case is also directed to ensure that complainant of this case also remain present before the mediation on the date fixed i.e 07.03.2025.
