Today is fixed for further hearing and report from A.G. Bengal, Kolkata.

Report in the form of affidavit has been received from Supriyo Banerjee, Sr. Accounts Officer, O/O the appointment General (A&E), West Bengal, Treasury Buildings, 2 Govt. Place (West), Kolkata-700001 along with photo copy of authorisation letter dated 19.12.2025 issued by Sr. Dy Accountant General(Administration) and a report regarding recovery in respect of Sri Nishikanta Mandal, Multi Tasking Staff dated 07.04.2026 issued by Sr. A.O/Admin-II.

Petitioner files *hazira* along with petition under order 21 rule 12 of CPC.

Respondent is also present filing *hazira*.

Heard. Considered.

The present execution proceeding arises out of Matrimonial Suit No. 590 of 2022 wherein, by Order No. 06 dated 12.09.2023, passed in a proceeding under Section 36 of the Special Marriage Act, the respondent/judgment-debtor was directed to pay a sum of ₹5,500/- *per mensem* to the petitioner/decreed-holder and a further sum of ₹2,400/- *per mensem* towards maintenance of their minor son, aggregating to ₹7,900/- *per mensem*, payable within the 10th day of each succeeding English calendar month.

Subsequently, the petitioner/decreed-holder initiated the present execution proceeding seeking realization of the maintenance amount accrued from March, 2023 to August, 2024, covering a period of eighteen months, amounting to ₹1,34,300/-.

Considering the fact that the judgment-debtor is a salaried employee under the Government of India, this Court, by Order No. 08 dated 29.08.2025, directed attachment of the aforesaid amount from the salary of the judgment-debtor through his employer. It was specifically disclosed by the petitioner/decreed-holder that the judgment-debtor is employed in the office of the Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal. Accordingly, the Senior Accounts Officer, Administration-I Section, Office of the Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal, No. 2 Government Place (West), Treasury Buildings, Kolkata – 700001, was directed to enforce the attachment.

Report has since been received from the concerned office stating that a sum of ₹1,34,300/- out of the total attached amount of ₹1,34,300/- has already been deducted from the salary of the judgment-debtor.

It further appears from report dated 08.10.2025 furnished by D.D.O &Sr. Accounts Officer/Admn.-II, office of Indian Audit And Accounts Department Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal, Treasury Buildings, 2 Government Place West, Kolkata-700001 that the amount so deducted has been retained under the PAO Suspense Account awaiting further orders of this Court regarding remittance thereof.

At this stage, the petitioner/decreed-holder has prayed for issuance of necessary direction upon the Senior Deputy Accountant General (Administration) for remittance of the attached amount in her favour.

In view of all the materials lying in the record the Senior Deputy Accountant General (Administration), office of the Indian Audit And Accounts Department Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal, Treasury Buildings, 2 Government Place West, Kolkata-700001 is directed to pay to this court the attached salary amounting ₹1,34,300/-(Rs. One lakh thirty four thousand three hundred only) of Sri Nishikanta Mandal, Multi Tasking Staff(judgement debtor/ opposite party) towards satisfaction of the order under execution or to appear and show causes as to why he should not do so.

Accordingly, let the matter be fixed on **17.06.2026** for **payment of the attached salary amounting ₹1,34,300/-(Rs. One lakh thirty four thousand three hundred only) of Sri Nishikanta Mandal, Multi Tasking Staff(judgement debtor/ opposite party)** unto this court towards satisfaction of the order under execution by the **Senior Deputy Accountant General (Administration), office of Indian Audit And Accounts Department Accountant General (A&E)**, West Bengal, Treasury Buildings, 2 Government Place West, Kolkata-700001, or to appear and show causes as to why he should not do so..

Let a copy of this order be forwarded to the Senior Deputy Accountant General (Administration), office of Indian Audit And Accounts Department Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal, Treasury Buildings, 2 Government Place West, Kolkata-700001, for information and necessary compliance.

Further orders shall be passed thereafter.
