Sukhjinder Singh Versus State of Punjab

ORDER:

This order will dispose of bail application under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, filed by petitioner Sukhjinder Singh, in case FIR No.208 dated 14.9.2019, under Section 341, 427, 323, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Nathana, Bathinda.

2. Heard. It is the plea of petitioner/accused that earlier, he was granted regular bail, but later on, the petitioner/accused could not appear before the learned trial Court and the Court has issued non-bailable warrants of the petitioner/accused on 9.4.2025. It is further stated that the petitioner/accused could not appear before the learned trial Court, as he bonafidely mistook the date of hearing and remained under the impression

that the case is pending for 8.5.2025. The petitioner intentionally never mis-used the concession of bail. In such a scenario, petitioner/accused is directed to surrender before learned Trial Court at 10.00 A.M sharp, within seven days and move regular bail application explaining the reasons of his absence and learned Trial Court is directed to decide the bail application of petitioner/accused on the same day, keeping in view the submissions made by petitioner/accused in his bail application. Till then, in the event of his arrest, on the basis of non-bailable warrants issued against him by learned Trial Court, he shall be admitted on interim bail by police to its satisfaction with the following conditions:

- (i) that applicant/accused will surrender before learned Trial Court within seven days;
- (ii) that he shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence and
- (iii) that he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.

Record of learned trial Court be sent back with copy of this order for compliance. File of bail application be consigned to the record room.
