It is submitted that the scrutiny of documents qua the applications filed under Section 230 BNSS on behalf of accused persons namely A-3/ Manisha Sanjay Havaladar (IA-08/26), A-4/ Tejas Harshad Kumar Shah (IA-09/26), A-5/ Shivraj Raghunath Motegaonkar (IA-10/26), A-6/ Dr. Manoj Bhagwanrao Shirure (IA-11/26) and A-8/ Dhananjay Nivrutti Lokhande (IA-12/26) has been completed. Ld. Counsels for the said accused persons submit that the major issue was related to pagination of the documents attached with the charge-sheet which stands sorted now. Accordingly, the said applications stand disposed off.

2. Ld. Counsel for A-2/ Prahlad Vithalrao Kulkarni, while taking this Court to certain paras of charge-sheet as well as the statements of witnesses, submits that certain documents have been discussed in the charge-sheet as well as in the statements of some of the LWs which as per record have been relied upon by the CBI but the same have not

been made part of the charge-sheet, therefore, CBI may be directed to place the same on record and the accused may also be provided copies thereof.

3. Ld. Sr. PP for CBI submits that whatever documents have been relied have already been placed on record and copies have been provided to each accused person. Ld. Sr. PP further submits that as far as the present stage is concerned, they have provided each and every document which is relied upon as on date. Ld. Sr. PP further submits that in case, subsequently, the CBI chooses to rely upon certain other documents, they will seek permission of the Court as per law.

4. Since, the issues raised in the applications (IA-06/26 & IA-07/26) filed under Section 230 BNSS on behalf of A-2 are still pending, therefore, it is deemed appropriate that CBI should file a proper reply to the said applications.

5. **Put up on 19.08.2026. All the accused persons are remanded to JC and be produced through VC on 19.08.2026.**

6. At request of Ld. Counsel for A-9, let the application moved u/s 94 BNSS be put up at 11.30 AM.
