ORDER :

1. The instant bail application for grant of regular bail under section 439 of Cr.P.C., has been filed by the above said applicant, who has been involved as accused in above referred case.
2. As per averments made by the applicant, he has falsely been implicated in this case and he never committed the alleged offence. The accused/applicant is in custody since 4.6.2019. He is no longer required by the police. Investigation has already been completed and final report U/s 173 Cr.P.C., has been furnished before the court. Section 326 of IPC has been added only to make the offence non bailable. Further detention of the applicant/accused is not likely to serve any purpose. As such, the accused/applicant be admitted to bail.
3. No formal reply was filed, but, grant of bail was opposed

by Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State, stating that the allegations levelled against the accused/applicant are quite serious in nature.

4. I have heard Learned defence counsel for the applicant/accused, Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State and gone through the material on record. Arguments have been made ad-verbatim.

5. From the perusal of record, it reveals that this case was registered on the basis of statement of Ranjit Singh, who got recorded that on 1.4.2019 he along with his son Gurpreet Singh and Sunil was present in their house. At 8.00 p.m., Balvir Singh came in front of their house and started hurling abuses. When complainant came out, he saw that Balvir Singh armed with Kapa, his son Prince armed with Kirpan and Sonu armed with Dang and Channo w/o Balvir Singh were present there and they opened attack on him and his wife Neelam Kaur. The accused/applicant has specifically been named in the FIR and specific role in the commission of alleged offence has been attributed to him. The accusations levelled against the accused/applicant are too serious to be ignored. Moreover, if the accused/applicant is enlarged on bail, there is every likelihood of his threatening and influencing material witnesses of the case, which became more evident from the statement of complainant recorded during proceedings of this bail application, whereby he stated that he did not want to proceed against the applicant/accused and had no objection if bail is granted to him. Hence, keeping in view the nature

and gravity of offence, the bail application in hand is, hereby,
dismissed. File be consigned to the record room.
