

State Vs. Kaka Singh BA-1028-2026

Bail application put up today before me being Duty Magistrate as 29.06.2026 has been declared holiday by the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court on account of sad demise of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Mahabir Singh Sindhu. Police record received. This order shall dispose of the bail application filed by learned counsel for the applicant/accused Kaka Singh in case bearing FIR No.182 dated 22.06.2026, under Section 61/1/14 of Excise Act, PS Sadar Dhuri.

2. It is averred in the bail application by learned counsel for the applicant/accused that applicant/accused has been falsely implicated in the present case by the police and he is in judicial custody since 22.06.2026. It is further averred that nothing has been recovered from the applicant/accused nor anything is to be recovered from him. Hence, a prayer is made to allow the present bail application.

3. Notice of the bail application was given to the Ld. APP for the State and report from SHO Police Post Bhalwan, P.S. Sadar Dhuri was received, wherein it has been submitted that there are several other cases under Excise Act and NDPS Act are pending against the applicant/accused. Ld. APP for the State has orally opposed the bail application on the ground that accused is a habitual offender and there are several other cases under Excise Act and NDPS Act are pending against him. Hence, a prayer is made for the dismissal of the present bail application.

I have heard the learned counsel for applicant/accused as well as Ld. APP for the State and have gone through the police record and case file carefully. Perusal of the record transpires that accused is a habitual offender and there are several cases pending against him under the Excise Act and NDPS Act, therefore, no ground is made out to allow the bail application of the applicant/accused. In view of the above discussion, this court is of the considered view that accused does not deserve any concession of bail at this stage. Accordingly, present bail application is hereby dismissed. Papers be tagged with the main file and be sent to the learned concerned Court.
