ORDER

1) This order of mine shall dispose of first regular bail application
filed by the applicant in the above mentioned FIR.

2) Ld.counsel for the applicant has submitted that this case has
been registered against unknown person, who had committed theft into the
house of complainant Amrish Goyal by trespassing. There is no eye witness
to the occurrence and the basic ingredients of the offence are missing. False
recovery has been planted upon applicant. The residential house from where
the recovery has been effected is neither owned nor possessed by the
applicant. He has prayed for the acceptance of the bail application.

3) On the other hand, Ld.Addl.P.P.for the State has opposed the
bail application alleging that heavy recovery of gold has been effected from
applicant and as such, he deserves no concession of being released on bail.
Police record was produced, which was seen and returned.

4) Perusal of the file reveals that the instant case was registered on the statement of complainant Amrish Goyal against unknown persons, who had committed theft of gold jewellery, silver utensils and Rs.4 lacs in cash from his house on the night of 14.5.2020 by breaking open their locks as they were away from their house. Vide Rapat No.44 dt.17.5.20, accused Karanvir Singh, Kalu Ram were nominated on 18.5.2020. Karanvir Singh and Kalu Ram were apprehended on Aactiva bearing No.PB03BA9689 and 19 gold bangles and 4 gold Karas, all weighing 364 gm were recovered from them. Thereafter, Karanvir Singh also got recovered gold ornaments weighing 242 gm and 2 Kgs. 300 gm silver ornaments, utensils and coins, whereas Kalu Ram had pursuant to his disclosure statement got recovered gold ornaments weighing 395 gm.

5) So, from the version of the prosecution, it is evident that heavy recovery of gold ornaments and silver ornaments had been effected from applicant. One DVR was also recovered from applicant. Applicant appears to be habitual in committing thefts that such a heavy recovery had been effected from him. So, keeping in view the circumstances of the case, I find no sufficient ground to release the applicant on bail. Hence, his bail application stands declined. File be put up before the learned Sessions Judge, Bathinda on 17.7.2020 for proper entrustment.
