ORDER.

Jagmeet Kumar alias Jaggu (applicant/accused), has
filed instant bail application under **Section 482 of B.N.S.S** on the

ground that, he is innocent, has nothing to do with the said offence. Even otherwise, there is undue and unexplained delay of about 9 months in lodging the FIR, which has been used for due deliberations and consultations. The applicant/accused is Chowkidar of the village and on 20.10.2024, was on night duty in the area of Village. The only alleged allegations against him are that he allegedly prepared video of indecent act committed by co-accused/non-applicant. Neither he committed any indecent and inappropriate acts with victimxxx nor shared the video to anybody. Now, the police officials of **Police Station Sadar, Ferozepur**, at behest of complainant, are conducting raids in the house of the accused-applicant. He is ready to join the investigation, if in that event IO/SHO/arresting officer be directed that on doing so, he be released on bail. *(Application is duly supported with affidavit).*

2. Upon notice, ***Ms. Teena, learned Additional Public Prosecutor***, for the State appeared. No reply to the application has been filed but hotly contested the same. It is submitted that since, he is the applicant/accused who after preparing video of the indecent and inappropriate acts committed by co-accused got the same viral, therefore, opposed prayer.

3. **Karma Singh** son of Rajpal Sachdeva (*complainant*) moved application before Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, thereby alleging that, his marriage was solemnized with Victimxxxx(name withheld) in the year 2001 and out of this wedlock two children were born. On 20.10.2024, at about 11:00 PM, a person named Gurmeet Singh after alluring enticed away his wife and thereafter, at about 1:00 PM, left her in the street. At that time, one unknown boy, tried to commit indecent and inappropriate acts with his wife and the entire incident was captured and converted into video by Jagmeet Singh alias Jaggu (Chowkidar) on his mobile phone and, the said video was shared with Ravi Monga, who further got the same viral by adding bad words, which tarnish their image in the society. Prayer made for taking action. After inquiry, instant case under Sections **75,126(2), 61(2), 79 of BNS and section 67(A) of Information and Technology Act** was got registered.

4. After having considering rival submissions put forth by counsel for both the parties and as per allegations set out in the FIR, applicant/accused made video clip of the occurrence, which was further sent to one Ravi Monga, who by writing indecent words on video against complainant and his wife, lateron got the same viral in

group. As such, custodial interrogation of **Jagmeet Kumar alias Jaggu** (*applicant/accused*) is warranted. If concession of pre-arrest bail has been granted, then it certainly will hamper police investigation. Hence, keeping in view the gravity of offence and above facts, bail application filed by **Jagmeet Kumar alias Jaggu** (*applicant/accused*) is, hereby, **dismissed**.

However, this order shall have no effect on the merits of the case. File be consigned to record room.
