CBI Vs. Rajiv Ranjan Ojha

As per the report of Ahlmad, Charge-Sheet along with documents is complete and the same has been checked.

Arguments on the point of cognizance heard and record perused.

The FIR No. 25/2014, dated 24.03.2014 under Section 7 r/w Section 13(1)(d) of P.C. Act was registered by Anti Corruption Branch, GNCT of Delhi on the complaint of Sh. Deepak Gupta, the then Chief Engineer, PWD Zone M3, GNCTD. The said complaint was based on sting operation aired by India TV News Channel on 22.03.2014 at 08.00 p.m. and repeat telecast was made on 23.03.2014 at 01.00 p.m, in which, the officials of PWD have been shown to be accepting and demanding bribe. During the investigation of the said FIR, it was found that there were different sting operations at different times at different places, so, as per the legal opinion, the said FIR was splitted into 9 FIRs and out of the said 9 FIRs, 4 FIRs i.e. 25/14, 40/14, 41/14 and 45/14 were transferred to CBI and as per IO, the present case relates to FIR No. 41/2014, registered with ACB, GNCT, Delhi. It is submitted that the CBI has registered the present case as RC0032025A0018, dated 20.03.2025.

The investigation revealed that Shri Farooqui Nawazi, Correspondent of India TV was approached by Shri Sunil Chaudhary of M/s. Hari Om Electronics and he stated himself to be a PWD Contractor and he had stated that PWD officials are demanding bribe for clearing his genuine

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bills. In order to expose corruption, Shri Farooqui Nawazi, Correspondent of India TV accompanied the above-named Contractor Shri Sunil Chaudhary in various offices of PWD, M-352 Division and recorded instances of bribe taking in his hidden camera. As per the investigation, Inspector Satyender Dhull of ACB, GNCT of Delhi collected raw footages of the sting operation from India TV and deposited the same in the FSL, Rohini, Delhi for examination. The FSL had given its report dated 23.12.2014 of 9 footages that were splitted. The split was done, as per the legal advice/ opinion.

It is also the case of prosecution that DVD no.1 (File No. AVF-1) provided by FSL, Rohini, Delhi pertains to the present case, wherein, the accused Rajiv Ranjan Ojha, the then JE, was caught accepting bribe from Shri Sunil Chaudhary, Contractor. It is further submitted that in the video clip, it was seen that accused Rajiv Ranjan Ojha was seen talking to the Contractor Sunil Chaudhary for the clearance of pending bills and taking bribe. The relevant portion of the transcript is mentioned in the Charge-Sheet. It is submitted by the IO that as per the statements of Shri Sunil Chaudhary as well as Shri Farooqui Nawazi, Correspondent of India TV, they have stated that an amount of Rs.11,000/- was handed-over to Shri Rajiv Ranjan Ojha towards bribe. It is further submitted by him that the video clips also show that the amount has been handed-over to him. It is submitted that as per the transcripts also, an amount of Rs.11,000/- was handed-over to the accused. The Sanction Order (D-9) against accused was granted by Shri Harish Kumar, Deputy Director, Directorate General, CPWD, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, New Delhi on 02.03.2026. It is submitted by the IO that specimen voices of Sunil Chaudhary and accused Rajiv Ranjan Ojha were forwarded to FSL for examination and

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opinion and FSL report dated 27.10.2020 confirms that the aforesaid specimen voices matched with the voices of sting operation, wherein, accused Rajiv Ranjan Ojha is demanding and accepting bribe from the Contractor for clearing the bills.

There is more than sufficient material on the record to take cognizance under Section 7 and Section 13(1)(d) of P.C. Act, 1988 in the present case against the accused. Accordingly, issue summons against the accused Rajiv Ranjan Ojha, returnable for 02.06.2026.
