Today, Sh. Rishabh Gupta, appearing as authorized representative for following 11 workmen has submitted that the said 11 workmen have settled their claim/dispute against management and consequently a joint application for withdrawal of their case/claim against the management has been filed today by said 11 workman, namely :

In abovesaid joint application filed by 11 workmen for withdrawal of their case/claim against management, said 11 workmen have stated that they have received respective settlement amount by way of demand draft from the management and in support of the application, affidavits have been filed by all abovesaid 11 workmen alongwith their Memorandum of Settle-

ment (except Memorandum of Settlement of workmen namely Sh. Shyam Lal Maurya and Smt. Suman Siwach).

Thus, on the basis of the abovesaid joint application of 11 workmen supported with their respective affidavits as well as in view of the submissions of their authorized representative Sh. Rishabh Gupta, present case/claim stands disposed off as settled, in respect of 11 workmen namely (i) Ms. Arti Sharma W/o Sh. Arun Sharma (ii) Sh. Anil Kumar S/o Sh. Mata Prasad (iii) Sh. Mahesh Jha S/o Sh. Devchander Jha (iv) Sh. Ravi Kant Yadav Sh. Markanday Yadav (v) Sh. Shyam Lal Maurya S/o Sh. Sukh Ram (vi) Sh. Suraj Muriya S/o Sh. Sangam Lal (vii) Sh. Jagdish Prasad Koli S/o Sh. Panna Lal (viii) Smt. Suman Siwach W/o Inderjeet (ix) Ms. Savita Garg W/o Sh. Davinder Kumar Garg (x) Sh. Vinod Kumar Nautiyal S/o Sh. Basba Nand Nautiyal and (xi) Sh. Vijay Kumar Hans S/o Sh. Jai Gopal Hans. Common settlement Award has been passed in respect of all the aforesaid 11 workmen.

Further, Sh. Rishabh Gupta, has submitted that another 5 workmen had already settled their claim/dispute against management and a joint application for withdrawal of their case/claim against the management has already been filed on behalf of the said 5 workmen, namely :

In said pending joint application of aforesaid 5 workmen for withdrawal of their case/claim against management, they have stated that they have already received their respective settlement amount by way of demand draft from the management and in

support of the their application, affidavits have been filed by all abovesaid 5 workmen.

Thus, on the basis of the joint application of afore-said 5 workmen supported with their respective affidavits as well as in view of the submissions of their authorized representative Sh. Rishabh Gupta, present case/claim stands disposed off as settled in respect of the abovesaid 5 workmen namely (i) Sh. Mukesh Kumar S/o Sh. Prasadi Lal (ii) Sh. Babli Son/daughter of late Sh. Prasadi Lal (iii) Sh. Sant Ram S/o Sh. Ram Singh (iv) Sh. Quamare Azam Khan S/o Md. Kamruzzama Khan and (v) Sh. Mahavir Prasad Sh. Mathura Prasad Sharma. Common separate settlement Award has been passed in respect of all the afore-said 5 workmen namely namely (i) Sh. Mukesh Kumar S/o Sh. Prasadi Lal (ii) Sh. Babli Son/daughter of late Sh. Prasadi Lal (iii) Sh. Sant Ram S/o Sh. Ram Singh (iv) Sh. Quamare Azam Khan S/o Md. Kamruzzama Khan and (v) Sh. Mahavir Prasad S/o Sh. Mathura Prasad Sharma.

Sh. Sumit Gupta has appeared as authorized representative for workmen Vinod s/o Sh. Suleman, Mujammil Khan s/o Mubarik and Satya Dev Prasad s/o Sh. Raghu Prasad and filed his Vakalatnama today and same be taken on record.

Sh. Sumit Gupta, AR has submitted that Vinod, Mujammil Khan and Satya Dev Prasad have settled their claim/dispute with management and he has placed on record the Memorandum of Settlements in respect of each of three workmen. He has submitted that these workmen are left with no claim/dispute against the management and therefore, the case/claim be disposed off as settled qua them. Separate statements of workmen Vinod, Mujammil Khan and Satya Dev

Prasad have been recorded to this effect.

In view of the Memorandum of Settlement as well as their statements, the case/claim of workman Vinod, Mujammil Khan and Satya Dev Prasad against management stands disposed off as settled. Accordingly, separate Settlement Awards have been passed today in respect of each of workmen namely Vinod, Mujammil Khan and Satya Dev Prasad.

Sh. Mukesh Kumar, AR appearing for remaining workmen, has submitted that LCA No.688/2022, which was filed before Ld. POLC-VI, RADC regarding 175 workmen (which includes the workmen of the present case), is pending before Ld. POLC-VI, RADC and he has prayed that for proper and fair adjudication of matter, the present case be transferred to Court of Ld. POLC-VI, RADC for further proceedings.

In view of the prayer made by Sh. Mukesh Kumar, AR, this Court is of the opinion that since connected case between same parties (that is, LCA No.688/2022) is already pending before Ld. POLC-VI, RADC, therefore, let present case be transferred to Court of Ld. POLC-VI, RADC for proper adjudication of the case.

Accordingly, let copy of this order be sent to Commissioner-cum-Secretary Labour Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi with request to transfer the present case to the Court of Ld. POLC-VI, RADC, where another connected case between same parties is pending.

Matter be put up further proceedings on **24.07.2026**.
