ORDER

1. This order of mine shall dispose of bail application moved by the accused Hardeep in which it has been stated that he is falsely implicated in this case and he has not committed any offence as alleged. He is in custody since his arrest. Therefore, prayer has been made for concession of bail to the accused.

2. Reply to the bail application not filed, but Ld. APP for the State orally stated that accused alongwith his co-accused have committed theft in TDI City on 10/11/07.2020. They are 7/8 persons, who committed theft and out of them four accused ran away from the spot and four accused were apprehended red handed. Therefore, the Ld. APP for the State prayed for dismissal of the bail application on the above grounds.

3. I have heard the Ld. Counsel for the accused and Ld. APP for the State and have gone through the police file.

4. Recovery has already been effected from the accused persons. It is yet to be established on record by way of appreciating the evidence during the course of trial, whether the accused committed theft or not. Therefore, keeping in view the fact that recovery has already been effected from the accused during remand, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him behind the bar any more rather it would be an extra burden on the State exchequer. Moreover, conclusion of trial shall take time. Therefore, accused Hardeep is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety of the like amount, subject to conditions of bail as follows:

(i) That applicant/accused shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence.

(ii) That accused/applicant will not leave the country without prior permission of the court.

5. Requisite bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. Papers be attached with the remand papers and be sent back to the court concerned.
