Report from the concerned police station has been received. It has been reported that applicant Mangal Singh has joined the investigation on 07.06.2022. It has been further reported that recovery has not been got effected and name of other co-accused also have not been disclosed. On the other hand, learned counsel for the applicant has contended that he has been falsely implicated in this case due to personal rivalry and FIR has been got registered late in this case after occurrence and applicant has not stolen anything. Heard. Considered. Keeping in view the contents of the FIR if at the time of occurrence on 12.04.2022 complainant had identified the Mangal Singh applicant while committing the theft along-with unknown persons, then nothing has been explained why he made statement on 29.05.2022 for got registering the present FIR. There is unexplained delay in got lodging the FIR. So, in these circumstances, role and liability of the applicant will be seen during trial. Further interrogation of the applicant is not required. Hence, interim order dated 02.06.2022 is made absolute. File be consigned to the record room.
