

Sarabjit Kaur Versus Deepak Singh @ Deepu

Heard on the bail application filed on behalf of petitioner Deepak Singh @ Deepu.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has invited my attentions towards the order dated 19.03.2024 passed by the Court of Ms. Jyoti Kumari, Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Bathinda, to argue that the petitioner has been summoned to face trial in a criminal complaint arising out of criminal complaint case bearing No.COMI-371/2021, titled as 'Sarabjit Kaur Vs. Gurpreet Singh etc.'. He argued that the petitioner is ready to join the trial proceedings and associate with the trial proceedings, however, he apprehends his arrest, as the Court has subsequently proceeded to take coercive methods against the petitioner seeking his presence.

Since the matter is involving from a criminal compliant, notice to non-applicant issued, returnable for 30.1.2025. However, keeping in view the totality of the circumstances as well as the fact that the petitioner has offered to join the trial proceedings, the petitioner is directed to join the trial proceedings on or before the next date of hearing fixed in this case. However, in the event of the arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer/Court concerned, the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate/Trial Court.

Now, file be put up on 30.01.2025 for further proceedings. Record of the trial court be returned alongwith copy of this order with the direction to the concerned Court to send the record on the date fixed.
