ORDER

Vide this order, I shall dispose of application for bail, particulars of which are giving herein above, preferred under Section 483 of B.N.S.S, by aforesaid applicant.

2) The case of the Investigating Agency, in nutshell, is that FIR in question was registered against the accused on the basis of statement of complainant Akashdeep Singh son of Nikka Singh, wherein he has stated that he is working as labourer. His two aunts namely Binder Kaur wife of Manohar Singh and Babu Kaur wife of Mithu Singh, residents of Sadhan Wali Basti are married at Kot Ise Khan. His elder aunt Binder Kaur's son Sagar Singh had a Shagun ceremony on 14.12.2025. This program was held at his aunt Binder Kaur's house. He came to his aunt's house in Sadhan Wali Basti, Kot Ise Khan, with his family to attend the program, but his younger brother Arshdeep Singh did not come with them. Shagun Programme was

going on in his aunt's house. His younger aunt Babu Kaur's daughter Khushi Kaur had a love marriage with his younger brother Arshdeep Singh in September 2024. Khushi Kaur stayed at their house for about three months, after which she got angry with his brother Arshdeep Singh and came to Kot Ise Khan, and has been living at her parental home since then. Because of this, his younger aunt Babu Kaur has kept grudge against their family. Nandi @ Akash son of unknown, resident of Sadhan Wali Basti, Kot Ise Khan, who is residing adjacent to the house of his younger aunt, had told him and his younger brother Arshdeep Singh some time ago that they would teach them a lesson for performing the love marriage. Around 10:15 PM, when the Shagun Programme was ended and he was preparing to go home with his family, suddenly Nandi @ Akash son of unknown, resident of Sadhan Wali Basti, Kot Ise Khan, District Moga, along with William and Sunny sons of Shinderpal Singh, residents of Dharamkot Road, Kot Ise Khan, District Moga, came to his aunt Binder Kaur's house on the instructions of his aunt Babu Kaur. They started scuffling with him and also abusing him. Then William took out a pistol from his bag and tried to fire directly towards him with the intention to kill him. Manjinder Singh son of Bohar Singh, resident of Khosa Randhir, District Moga, his maternal uncle's son who was standing near William, quickly raised William's pistol hand to save his life. As a result of which, the bullet fired from the pistol hit on the left side of left leg knee and exited from the right side. He started screaming in pain. Then all accused persons fled from the spot alongwith their weapons. His family members then arranged a vehicle and got him admitted to Civil Hospital Moga for treatment, from where he was referred to Guru Gobind Singh Medical College and Hospital, Faridkot, for further treatment. On the basis of aforesaid statement of complainant, FIR was registered against the accused/applicant. The accused/applicant was arrested in this case on 19.12.2025.

3). I have heard learned counsel for applicant-accused as well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State and have gone through the record.

4). From perusal of FIR, it reveals that allegations against accused-applicant are that accused/applicant with the common intention of her co-accused had caused injuries on the person of complainant with an intention to kill him. Now, nothing is to be recovered from the accused/applicant and culpability of the accused/applicant shall be gauged during trial. The accused/applicant is in custody in this case since 19.12.2025. As such, keeping in view of the facts and circumstances of the present case and the fact that accused/applicant is in custody since the date of arrest and it will take considerable time for conclusion of trial. I am of the view that in given circumstances, no useful purpose is going to be served by keeping the accused/applicant in custody for longer period. As such, the accused/applicant is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing her bail bonds and surety bonds to the tune of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to the following conditions:-

1. That the applicant will not tamper with the prosecution evidence.
2. That the applicant will appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing.
3. That the applicant will not leave country without prior permission of court.

5). It is further made clear that in case of any violation thereof, this order shall cease to have effect qua the same. Papers be attached with relevant record.
