O R D E R:-

This order of mine shall decide this application for pre-arrest bail under section 438 of Cr.P.C., filed in the above noted FIR on behalf of applicant, on the allegations that she is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. No injury is attributed to the applicant/accused. FIR was registered against unknown persons.

Applicant/accused is ready to join investigation. Nothing is to be recovered from the applicant, so her custodial interrogation is not required. Hence, it is prayed that the application be allowed and applicant be given the concession of pre-arrest bail.

2. Notice of bail application was issued to State and Sh. Dalip Kumar, Learned Public Prosecutor put in appearance on behalf of State. Sh. J.S.Kalra Advocate also put in appearance on behalf of complainant. Record has also been requisitioned.

3. I have heard arguments of learned counsel for applicant and learned Public Prosecutor for State, assisted by learned counsel for complainant and have gone through the record.

4. As per report of filing branch clerk, no bail application filed by applicant/accused is pending in the Hon'ble High Court. He has attached on record copy of report downloaded from the website of Punjab and Haryana High Court.

5. The case was registered on the basis of application moved by Bholi that on 28.02.2021, accused Paramjit Kaur, Gurmit Singh and Chhindo have committed murder to her husband by inflicting injuries and that applicant/accused alongwith others used to entice them not to vacate the house of the complainant and used to threatened the complainant and her husband.

6. So, the allegations of causing death of husband of complainant is not against the applicant/accused. She is only accused of enticing co-accused for not vacating the house of complainant. Considering all these facts, applicant/accused is directed to join investigation. In case she is required to be arrested, she be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. The applicant shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.

7. Now file be put up on 18.07.2023.
