ORDER

1. An application for grant of regular bail in a case FIR No.24 dated 29.03.2024, under Section 376(2)(3) of the IPC and Section 6 of the POCSO Act, Police Station, Sherpur has been filed on behalf of applicant-accused.
2. Upon notice, Sh.Munish Singla, Addl. PP appeared on behalf of State.
3. I have heard the learned counsel for the applicant-accused and learned Addl. PP for the State and have gone through the record.
4. Learned counsel for the applicant-accused has submitted that

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applicant-accused is innocent. He has not committed any offence. He has been falsely implicated in the present case. He is in judicial custody since long. The conclusion of trial will take long time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the applicant-accused behind the bars. So the bail application of the applicant-accused be allowed.

5. On the other hand, learned Addl. PP for the State has opposed the bail application on the ground that grave and serious offences have been committed by the applicant-accused, so bail application of the applicant-accused be dismissed.

6. Prosecution case is that on 29.03.2024 at about 3:30 PM, accused Shinderpal Singh @ Shinda took away complainant's minor daughter/victim alleged to be deaf and dumb and mentally retarded on his scooty bearing registration No.PB-08BT-1117 to the fields and committed rape/ penetrative sexual assault upon her. Complainant/ victim's father when saw the accused taking away his minor victim daughter, he followed him and when he reached at the spot, he saw that accused was doing a wrongful act with his minor daughter. On the basis of the statement of the complainant, an FIR under Section 376(2)(i) of the IPC and Section 6 of the POCSO Act was registered against accused Shinderpal Singh @ Shinda. The allegations against the applicant-accused of committing penetrative sexual assault upon the minor deaf and dumb and mentally retarded victim are serious and grave in nature. So, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the nature of the allegations and the conduct of the applicant-accused, the bail application of the

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applicant-accused is dismissed. Any observation made in this order shall have no effect on the merit of the case. Bail application file be attached with the main file.
