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ORDER

1. Record from the concerned Police Station received. Heard on the bail application under section 439 Cr.P.C filed on behalf of the accused/applicant Amar Pal Singh Gill.
2. The case arising out of FIR No.47 of 09.2.2018, U/ss 454, 380, 411 IPC relating to P.S. Division No.5, Ludhiana has been registered on the basis of statement of complainant Ms. Veena Bhardwaj which she got recorded to the Investigating Officer on 09.2.2018 stating therein accused has been caught red handed while taking away

LCD/Desktop) belonging to complainant.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant/accused argued accused is quite innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. No offence as alleged in the FIR has ever been committed by him. Nothing is to be recovered from him and accused was arrested on 09.2.2108 and since then he is in custody and in the last prayer has been made for admitting the accused/applicant on bail.
4. On the other hand, learned Addl.P.P for the State has opposed the bail application filed on behalf of the accused and prayed for dismissal of the same.
5. Accused is already in judicial custody since 09.2.2018 and the perusal of record reveals that challan in the present against the accused is still to be presented . No useful purpose would be served by keeping him behind the bar anymore as the conclusion of trial will take considerable time and allegations are still to be substantiated by way of evidence led at the trial.
6. So, keeping in view the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case referred to above, accused is ordered to be released on bail subject to furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 70,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned trial court/Duty Magistrate and subject to the conditions to be imposed by the said court.

Concerned Ahlmad of this court is directed to return the police record/file to the concerned official/naib court on proper

verification and against proper receipt whereas bail application file
be consigned to record room, Ludhiana.
