Ld.counsel appearing on behalf of applicant has contended that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the applicant has joined investigation and now his custodial interrogation is not required.

On the other hand, Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor, on instructions from ASI Baldev Singh has not controverted the fact the applicant has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required. Separate statement of ASI Baldev Singh has also been recorded to the said effect.

After considering the above, as prosecution has stated that the applicant has already joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the order dated 02.01.2025 whereby the applicant was granted the interim protection, is hereby made absolute on the terms and conditions incorporated U/s.482(2) of BNSS.
