Heard on the regular bail application moved by Sh. Gurwinder Pal, Advocate on behalf of applicant/accused Jagroop Singh son of Baldev Singh. It is submitted in the application that the accused/applicant is innocent and falsely implicated in the present case. Applicant/accused was arrested on 26.12.2024 and he is in judicial custody with effect from 27.12.2024. It is further submitted that alleged recovery if any has already been effected. It is further submitted the accused is the only bread winner of his family and the accused is no more required for any purpose & investigation. Hence the present application.

Notice of the bail application was given to the State through Ld. APP for the State who did not file any written reply but orally opposed the bail application. Police record was also perused. Statement of ASI Amarjit

Singh No.2328/Btl, PS Sekhwan, Batala has also been recorded wherein he stated that no other case is pending against the applicant/accused except the present case. He stated that except the present bail application, no other bail application pertaining to applicant/accused is decided or pending in any court of law.

I have heard the Ld. APP for the State as well as the Learned Defence Counsel and have also gone through the record.

As per record, present FIR has been registered against accused/applicant on the allegations that on 26.12.2024, ASI Amarjit Singh along with police party were on patrolling duty and were present at bridge canal of village Tatl where two young persons were seen coming, who on seeing the police party got perplexed and tried to turn back. However, they were apprehended by the police and on being confronted by the police, that one accused disclosed his name as Navraj Singh and another accused/applicant disclosed his name as Jagroop Singh. On personal search of co-accused Navraj Singh, one transparent polythene was recovered from his jacket which was found to have containing three grams of heroin which was taken into police possession vide separate possession memo.

Perusal of the file further reveals that the present accused was arrested on 26.12.2024 and was produced before the court on 27.12.2024 and since then he is in judicial custody. The recovery of 3 gram of heroin has already effected from the co-accused Navraj Singh who has already been granted bail and challan is yet to be presented in the present case. The guilt or innocence of the accused in the present case will be proved by way

of evidence during the trial which will take time. No fruitful purpose will be served by keeping the accused behind the bars for indefinite time. Hence, this Court deems it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the applicant/accused. Accordingly, accused Jagroop Singh S/o Baldev Singh R/o Village Buttar Kalan, PO Qadian, Tehsil Batala, District Gurdaspur is ordered to be released on bail for the offences allegedly committed under sections 21-29-61-85 of NPDS Act in the present case subject to furnishing of bail bonds in sum of Rs. 40,000/- with one surety in like amount and subject to following conditions:-

1. He will appear in the court on each and every date of hearing unless his attendance or personal appearance is exempted by court.
2. He will not leave the country without permission of the Court.
3. He will not induce the witnesses of the case and will not tamper the evidence in any manner.

Requisite bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished and papers be attached with main file.
