Bail application presented today. It be registered. Notice of bail application has been issued to Ld. APP for the State for today itself.

Heard on the bail application moved by the counsel for the accused/applicant Sulinder Kaur @ Surinder Kaur, wherein it has been averred that in the present FIR, accused has been falsely implicated. The facts narrated in the FIR are false, frivolous and fabricated against the accused. The accused is innocent. Hence, this application.

Learned APP for the State did not file the reply but argued that accused shall not be released on bail keeping in view the gravity of the offence.

I have heard learned defence counsel and learned APP for the State on the application for bail of accused Sulinder Kaur @ Surinder Kaur. Perusal of the file shows that accused is in custody since 27.01.2021. Allegations against accused are under Section 61 of

Excise Act. No useful purpose would be served by detaining him in custody any further. Presentation of challan may take some time. Hence, accused is admitted to bail on her furnishing bail bond and surety bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in like amount, subject to the conditions as under:-

- Applicant shall appear before the learned trial court on each and every date of hearing.
- Applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of learned trial court.
- Applicant shall not make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with this case.

Bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished.
