4. I have heard learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State and learned counsel for the applicant/ accused.

5. Vide order dated 30.04.2020 the interim bail has been granted to the accused/applicant.

6. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State argued that accused/ applicant has joined the investigation. The bail application may kindly be disposed of as per law.

7. On the other hand learned counsel for the accused/ applicant argued that accused/ applicant has been falsely implicated in this case. Accused/ applicant has joined the investigation. The interim bail order may kindly be made absolute.

8. ASI Manohar Lal No.1312/Ptk has come present and suffered statement that present applicant/ accused has joined the investigation and

is not required for further custodial interrogation.

As the accused/applicant has already joined the investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation, therefore the interim bail order dated 30.04.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions as reflected therein. Copy of this order be sent to SHO/Investigating officer of police station concerned for information. Bail application file be consigned to the records.
