Summons issued to the accused not received back. Various time summons have been issued to the accused. However, in spite of issuance of the processes against the accused, none has appeared on the behalf of accused. Already the challan has been taken up on various dates and the process has been issued several time. This court is of the view that issuance of repeated process will not be in larger interest of justice. Moreover, this court is of considered opinion that the issuance of repeated process shall burden the state exchequer and the execution process may over-weigh the fine which has to be imposed on the accused on his appearance. Hence keeping in view the provision of Section 281 BNSS the proceedings are stopped. A note be given on the challan in red ink that same be not destroyed as it can be summoned again as and when required. Paper/challan be consigned to the record room after due compliance.
