Record is put up by petition filed on behalf of the custody accused, namely, Bishaka Adhikary.

The said accused has filed a petition for bail.

Copy served.

Ld. PP-in-charge and Ld. Lawyer for the accused are present.

The said bail petition is taken up for hearing.

Heard submission of the Ld. Lawyer for the accused.

Ld. PP-in-charge has voluntarily opposed the prayer for bail.

Considered.

It appears from the case record that accused Bishaka Adhikary is the prime accused for murder of Army Personnel. Charge has been framed in this case on 15.05.2025. One witness has been examined in this case as PW-1 and a schedule has been fixed from 25.02.2026 to 27.02.2026 for evidence of CSW-2, CSW-3, CSW-4, CSW-5 and CSW-32, who is the Autopsy Surgeon.

Considering the photocopy of the charge-sheet lying the case record, I find that this accused is actively involved behind the commission of murder of the Army Personnel and she took the prime role in the offence. The accused is a resident of Siliguri and Siliguri is well connected with other states of our country including Indo-Nepal and Indo-Bangladesh border.

In such circumstance, if the accused is enlarged on bail, there is every possibility that the accused may flee away and she cannot be brought for trial. In the aforesaid circumstance, considering the nature and gravity of the offence, I am not inclined to grant bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail is rejected.
