HR65-A-9208 by respondent No.1 and extent thereof? OPP.
2. Whether the claimant/injured is entitled to any compensation? If
so, to what extent and from whom? OPP.
3. Whether the driver of the offending vehicle was not holding a
valid driving license at the time of accident and has violated the
terms and conditions of the Insurance policy? If so, its
effect. OPR.

4. Relief.

No other issue arises or pressed. Now to come up on 06.08.2024 for evidence of the claimant/injured. Necessary list of witnesses, PF, DM be filed within 10 days.
