

**Criminal Misc. Case – 248 of 2026**  
**C.N.R. No. WBJP01-000724-2026**

**Order No. 02 dated 09.03.2026**

The application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the accused-petitioners, namely, 1. Biplab @ Krishna Chettri, 2. Prem Kumar @ Prem Kumar Barman, 3. Bharat @ Bhaskar Roy Pramanik and 4. Shibu @ Shubharanjan Pain praying for anticipatory bail in connection with N.J.P. P.S. Case No.14/2026 dated 03.01.2026 u/s-126(2)/117(2)/3(5)/74/351(2) of B.N.S., corresponding to P.T.N. No.WBJP02P000115/2026, is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused-petitioners submitted that no bail petition has ever been filed in connection with this case before any higher Court on any earlier occasion and an affidavit has also been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioners in support of such contention by the Ld. Defence Lawyer and the Ld. P.P, in-charge, Jalpaiguri conceded to the fact as submitted by the Ld. Defence lawyer.

It is the case of the accused-petitioners that they have been falsely implicated in this case out of personal grudge and vendetta. It has also been contended that there are case and counter case between the parties and the present case is the subsequent one. It has been contended further that all the alleged offences are triable by the Court of Ld. Judicial Magistrate (First Class). It has been contended further that no notice u/s 35(3) of B.N.S.S. has been issued upon the accused-petitioners. Considering the present facts and circumstances, it is prayed that these accused-petitioners may be granted with anticipatory bail subject to any condition with a promise to cooperate with investigation.

Ld. Public Prosecutor, in-charge, Jalpaiguri, opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Heard the Ld. Lawyer for the accused-petitioners and the Ld. Public Prosecutor, in-charge, Jalpaiguri.

Perused the T.C.R and the case diary. Considered.

The fact of the case in short is that the de-facto complainant and her husband attended a rice taking ceremony on 02.01.2026 at about 11:00 pm and at that time there was an altercation as a result of which the husband of the de-facto complainant was assaulted by a blade and he sustained injury. Hence, the F.I.R. was lodged and the instant case was started. In course of the hearing, Ld. Lawyer for the accused-petitioners filed some documents including the photocopy of the formal F.I.R. wherefrom it appears that the wife of the accused-petitioner no.1, namely, Biplab @ Krishna Chettri, lodged an F.I.R. over the self same incident prior to lodging of the F.I.R. of the instant case. I have carefully perused the F.I.R. There is no mention that the accused-petitioners outraged the modesty of the de-facto complainant. Considering the materials available in the C.D. and also the fact that there are case and counter case, I am inclined to allow the prayer for anticipatory bail filed u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. in respect of the accused-petitioners.

Hence, it is

**ORDERED**

that the instant anticipatory bail application filed u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. stands allowed.

Accordingly, this Court directs that in the event of arrest, the accused-petitioners, namely, 1. Biplab @ Krishna Chettri, 2. Prem Kumar @ Prem Kumar Barman, 3. Bharat @ Bhaskar Roy Pramanik and 4. Shibu @ Shubharanjan Pain shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.3,000/- each with two (2) sureties of Rs.1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, subject to the compliance of the condition as laid down in sub-section (2) of Section 482 of B.N.S.S. on condition that the accused-petitioners shall cooperate in the investigation by meeting the I.O. as and when called for and on further condition that the accused-petitioners shall not cause threat, intimidation or otherwise influence to the witnesses of this case.

Send a copy of this order along with T.C.R. to the Ld. C.J.M., Jalpaiguri, for information and taking necessary action.

Documents submitted by Ld. Lawyer for the accused-petitioners be kept with the case record.

Return C.D.

Thus, the Criminal Misc. case is disposed of.
