

Criminal Misc. Case – 283 of 2026

The application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the accused-petitioner, namely, Fullbala Roy @ Phulbala Roy praying for anticipatory bail in connection with Dhupguri P.S. Case No.44/2026 dated 09.02.2026 u/s-85/80(2)/3(5) of B.N.S., corresponding to P.T.N. No.WBJP000932/2026, is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused-petitioner submitted that no bail petition has ever been filed in connection with this case before any higher Court on any earlier occasion and an affidavit has also been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner in support of such contention by the Ld. Defence Lawyer and the Ld. P.P, in-charge, Jalpaiguri conceded to the fact as submitted by the Ld. Defence lawyer.

It is the case of the accused-petitioner that she has been falsely implicated in this case out of personal grudge and vendetta. It has also been contended that the present accused-petitioner is the mother-in-law of the victim aged about 61 years and she has no role to play in the alleged incident. Considering the present facts and circumstances, it is prayed that this accused-petitioner may be granted with anticipatory bail subject to any condition.

Ld. Public Prosecutor, in-charge, Jalpaiguri, opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Heard the Ld. Lawyer for the accused-petitioner and the Ld. Public Prosecutor, in-charge, Jalpaiguri.

Perused the T.C.R and the C.D. which is not paginated. Considered.

This is a case u/s 85/80(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. The present accused-petitioner is the mother-in-law of the victim who is alleged to have committed suicide as she could not continue the torture in the matrimonial home due to demand of dowry. The principal accused person i.e. the husband of the victim is in custody. The C.D. reveals that there was a demand of dowry and torture upon the victim. The death took place within seven (7) years from the date of the marriage. In such circumstances, considering the nature and gravity of the offence, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail filed u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. in respect of the present accused-petitioner.

Hence, it is

ORDERED

that the instant anticipatory bail application filed u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the accused-petitioner, namely, **Fullbala Roy @ Phulbala Roy** stands **rejected**.

Send a copy of this order along with T.C.R. to the Ld. C.J.M., Jalpaiguri, for information and taking necessary action.

The accused-petitioner is directed to surrender before the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalpaiguri, within seven (7) days.

Return C.D.

Thus, the Criminal Misc. case is disposed of.
