Arguments heard on the bail application filed by applicant/accused. Accused has been arrested on the allegations that present case was got registered on the statement of Tirath Singh son of Darshan Singh, resident of Sarai Kham, PS Sadar Nakodar to the effect that on 11.08.2023 at about 6.00 p.m. he was standing outside the gate of his house, the dog of their neibourer namely Balraj Singh son of Tarsem Singh who daily used to pass stool in front of his gate, came on that day and was to pass the stool. The complainant rebuked it, upon which the dog went in his house. Jasvir Kaur wife of Balraj Singh came outside and started abusing him, on hearing the noise of Jasvir Kaur, his daughter Prabhjot Kaur and his wife Simranjit Kaur also came there. Jasvir Kaur again sent the dog towards his house. The complainant again stopped it, in the meantime son of Jasvir Kaur, namely Gurpreet alias Ajay, son of Balraj Singh, Vishal son of Balraj Singh, her daughter Mannu alongwith two unknown persons came in front of their door. Mannu dragged his daughter from T-shirt and Gurpreet alias Ajay, Vishal and the two boys alongwith them had beaten his daughter Prabhjot Kaur and also torn her T-shirt. When complainant tried to save her,

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then Balraj Singh who was armed with Dati and his daughter who was armed with danda inflicted blow on the backside of his elbow. All the four boys, Jasvir Kaur alongwith her daughter Mannu and her husband Balraj gave beatings to him due to which he suffered internal injuries. They also pulled his turban. They forcibly entered in his house and again gave beatings to him. He raised hue and cry, upon with all the assailants ran away from the spot while giving threats.

Record perused. As per record, accused is in judicial custody since 18.08.2023. Presentation and disposal of challan is also going to take considerable time. Moreover, no specific allegation has been attributed to the present applicant/accused. His co-accused has already been granted bail. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused in custody for indefinite period. Infact it will be the burden on State exchequer. Thus, the present bail application of the accused namely Balraj Singh is allowed subject to furnishing the bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Accused is directed to come present each and every date of hearing. He is directed not to tamper with the prosecution evidence. He is also directed not to travel outside the country without prior permission of the court. Bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. Papers be tagged with the remand papers.
