ORDER

Accused persons present in person. At this stage accused persons present in the court have moved their respective applications for confession of offences under section 8/20/29 NDPS Act. The accused persons were warned that any confessional statement made by them may be used against them, however, they are insistent on making a confessional statement. Their statements were accordingly recorded and from the same offences under section 8/20/29 NDPS Act stand established against them. The accused are, therefore, convicted and are sentenced to simple imprisonment for 30 days and a fine of Rs. 3000/- each for commission of offences U/s 8/20/29 NDPS Act, in default of payment, he shall further undergo simple imprisonment for a period of 10 days. The accused persons have deposited total fine of Rs. 6000/- (Rupees six thousand only) before the Nazir of this court vide GR No. 3939765 dated 30.10.2023. Same be deposited into the Govt. Treasury under rules. It has been further stated that the accused persons have already spent the period of 30 days in the custody and as such period spent by them in custody shall be treated as period already undergone by them as simple imprisonment in this case. Accordingly, file is disposed off and be consigned to records.
