ORDER

This petition is filed under section 187(2) of BNSS.

2. Heard. Report filed, perused the records.

3. The petitioners / accused are in judicial custody from 31.01.2026. As the petitioners have completed 89 days of detention in judicial custody, this application is considered as a statutory bail application. I find that final report is not submitted. Hence the accused are entitled for bail on the following conditions:-

1. The petitioners shall execute bond for Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty thousand only) with two solvent sureties each for the like sum.
2. The petitioners shall not involve in similar nature of offences during bail period.

3. Petitioners shall not intimidate or influence the witnesses in any manner.
4. Petitioners shall co-operate with the investigation.
5. Petitioners shall not tamper with the evidence.
6. Petitioners shall appear before Investigating Officer as and when required in writing, till filing of Final report.
7. Violation of any of above condition will result in cancellation of bail granted to him.
