Arguments heard. During the course of arguments, it has transpired that inadvertently, Issue no 4 has not been correctly framed and inadvertently the relief of declaration has not been mentioned therein. As such, by invoking the provisions of Section 151 CPC, in the interest of justice, Issue no.4 is re-framed as under-

Issue no. 4 Whether the plaintiff is entitled to declaration and mandatory injunction as prayed for ? OPP
