ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

Today, the matter is kept for order. The record shows that, on previous date, the complainant, his Ld. Advocate and advocate for the accused were present. They have filed joint compromise Pursis at **Exh.73 and consent terms at Exh.74**. It bears signature of the both parties and their Ld. Advocates. The complainant has been identified by his learned advocate.

2. In view of withdrawal pursis **Exh.73 and consent terms at Exh.74**, the accused issued a demand draft in favour of the complainant. Therefore, the complainant does not want to proceed the present matter against the accused. The Ld. In-charge Court has recorded the voluntariness of the complainant to withdraw the present complaint. In this background, it is futile exercise to keeping the present matter in the record of this court. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

1. The complaint is disposed of as withdrawn.
2. The accused No.1 to 3 namely **Amarchand Lakhmichand Narang, Amit Amarchand Narang and Gunit Amit Narang** are hereby acquitted vide section 257 of the Code of

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Criminal Procedure of the offence punishable
u/s 138 of the N.I. Act.

3. The bail and bonds are hereby discharged.
4. Court fees be refunded to the complainant as per rule.
