The accused Sayan Roy and Bibek Debnath are produced through V/C.

Today is fixed for hearing of the bail petition dated 25.03.2026 filed on behalf of the accused persons.

Ld. Spl. PP Shri Debasish Dutta is present.

Ld. Advocate for the accused Sayan Roy is present. He has not pressed the application for bail on behalf of the accused, namely, Sayan Roy.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail filed on behalf of the accused, namely, **Sayan Roy**, stands **rejected being not pressed**.

Ld. Defence Lawyer for the accused Bibek Debnath is also present.

I.O. is present with the C.D.

The de-facto complainant is present.

The bail petition dated 25.03.2026 filed on behalf of the accused Bibek Debnath is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate, appearing on behalf of the accused person has submitted that no bail petition of this accused is either pending or was rejected before or by any Higher Forum.

It is submitted by Ld. Spl PP also that no bail petition of this accused is either pending or was rejected by any Higher Forum as it appears from the CD.

It is submitted on behalf of the accused that he is completely innocent, he has been falsely implicated in this case, all the allegations made against him are fabricated and concocted. In view of that it is prayed that he may be enlarged on bail on any condition.

Ld. Spl PP left the matter to the discretion of this Court. However, he has submitted that only Section 17 of the POCSO Act is attracted against the accused, Bibek Debnath.

Heard the de-facto complainant, who is the father of the victim girl. He has stated that he has no objection against the prayer for bail as filed on behalf of the accused Bibek Debnath.

I have carefully considered the materials on record. I have also examined the C.D including the statement of the victim girl recorded u/s 183 BNSS. I find that the accused is in custody for a considerable period. Investigation in this case has been completed and charge-sheet has already been submitted. Charge-sheet reveals that only Section 17 of the POCSO Act has been attracted against the accused Bibek Debnath. In view of above, I intend to enlarge the accused on interim bail.

The accused **Bibek Debnath** may find bail of Rs.5,000/- with two registered sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. CJM, Jalpaiguri on condition that:

- 1) he shall appear before this Court each and every date fixed;**
- 2) he shall not influence the victim and other witnesses or tamper with the evidence;**

The office of Ld. CJM, Jalpaiguri do arrange to fit the bail bonds of the registered sureties.

Let a copy of this order be sent to the Ld. CJM, Jalpaiguri for necessary action.
