

Court notice was issued to Plaintiff Nos. 1 to 4 and was personally served upon them. Notice issued to Plaintiff No. 5 was served upon her elder sister. Plaintiff Nos. 1 to 5 were called out, but remained absent.

The records disclose that the counsel who had been appearing for the plaintiffs had retired from the case after issuing prior intimation letters to the plaintiffs. Thereafter, this Court issued court notices to the plaintiffs. Despite service of the court notices, the plaintiffs did not choose to appear before the Court.

Hence, this Court is left with no other option but to dismiss the suit for default. Accordingly, the suit of the plaintiffs is dismissed for default.
