Order No. 06 dated 16.06.2026

The application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the accused-petitioner, namely, Nurmahammad Ansari, praying for anticipatory bail in connection with Banarhat P.S. Case No.81/2026 dated 08.04.2026 u/s-85 of B.N.S., is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Defense Lawyer has submitted that no bail petition has ever been filed in connection with this case before any Higher Court on any earlier occasion. An affidavit has been filed by Ld. Defense Lawyer in support of this submission.

Ld. Public Prosecutor, Jalpaiguri, has also submitted that no bail application of these accused-petitioner is either pending or was rejected before or by any higher forum, as it appears from the C.D.

It is submitted by the Ld. Defence Lawyer that this accused-petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He is completely innocent. He is no way connected with the alleged occurrence. There is no chance of his absconding as he has his permanent place of residence. In view of that, it is prayed that this accused-petitioner may be enlarged on anticipatory bail on any condition.

Ld. Public Prosecutor, Jalpaiguri, has left the matter to the discretion of this court, as chargesheet has been submitted in this case.

Heard Ld. Public Prosecutor, Jalpaiguri and Ld. Defence Lawyer.

I have carefully considered the C.D. and other materials on record. I find that charge-sheet has already been submitted in this case, as it appears from the C.D. It also appears that the case was initially started under section 85 of B.N.S. and after completion of investigation, charge-sheet also has been submitted only under Section 85 of B.N.S. Therefore, since charge-sheet has been submitted in this case, it is felt that custodial interrogation of this petitioner is not required for the purpose of investigation. In view of that, I intend to enlarge the accused-petitioner on pre-arrest bail.

The prayer for anticipatory bail filed on behalf of this accused-petitioner, namely, Nurmahammad Ansari in connection with the above referred case, is **allowed**.

In the event of arrest, the accused-petitioner, namely, Nurmahammad Ansari be released on furnishing bond of Rs.3,000/- with two (2) sureties of Rs.1,500/- each, subject to satisfaction of the arresting officer with a direction to comply the conditions contained in Section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. corresponding to previous Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.

Let a copy of this order along with T.C.R be sent to learned C.J.M, Jalpaiguri, for information and taking necessary action.

Return C.D.

The Criminal Misc. case is accordingly disposed of.
