

CRM-1602-2026. Anil Kumar Vs. Gaurav Syal.

The main file has been taken up on an application filed on behalf of the applicant, Ravi Kumar, seeking permission to withdraw the surety earlier furnished by him on behalf of the accused and to furnish a fresh surety. It has been submitted that the applicant had earlier stood surety for the accused. However, he now requires his property for his own purposes and, therefore, seeks to be discharged from the suretyship. It is further prayed that a fresh surety be permitted to be furnished in the shape of Fixed Deposit Receipts (FDRs). Heard. In view of the averments made in the present application, the same is hereby allowed. Fresh sureties furnished by all three appellants in the form of original FDRs are accepted and attested.
