

Order dated 10-02-2023

Record is put up today.

Charged is framed u/s of IPC.

The accused persons appear before this Court. Charged is framed and read over and explained to the accused persons as to whether they pleaded guilty. Accused persons pleaded not guilty. Petition is filed by the complainant and the injured praying for compounding of the offence. The offences are compoundable in nature. The defacto complainant as well as the victims also appear before the Court. Two petitions are filed, one is praying for permission to compound the case and another is praying for compounding the case. On dock on being asked the defacto complainant cum victim stated that they intend to compound the matter voluntarily with the accused person.

Permission sought. Granted.

Further on perusal of the record, it appears that this is a case u/s 341/323/504 of IPC whereby permission of the Court u/s 320(2) of Cr P C is required for compounding the offence.

Since the victim wants to compound the offence with the accused persons.

Hence, permission to compound the offence is allowed.

The accused persons are acquitted u/s 320(8) of the Cr.PC. Bail bonds is canceled. Sureties are discharged.
