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	<u>07.10.22</u>	A surrender cum bail petition along with Vakalatnama has been filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Mukund Hembram received from Filing Centre, Civil Courts, Dhanbad has been taken up for hearing. Heard learned counsel of petitioner. Learned lawyer appeared on behalf of the accused petitioner submit that the accused petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case only on the basis of suspicion and he is surrendering before the court voluntarily. It is further submitted that the accused petitioner has deposited his revenue loss amount of Rs. 12,590/- to the Electricity Department, Dhanbad. It has further been submitted that authenticated copy of the receipt has been filed along with petition. Hence, prayed to enlarge the accused petitioner on bail. Ld. Addl. P.P. has conceded the fact that the loss amount raised by the Electricity Department have already been paid by the accused petitioner. Considering the aforesaid facts and on perusal of case record, it transpires that on the written application of one Krishndev Prajapati, J.E.E. Electricity Department, this case has been registered as Chirkunda (Galfarbari O.P.) P.S. Case No. 254 of 2022. A raid has conducted by the official of the Electricity Department in the house of the accused petitioner at Tilakadih and the accused petitioner was found committing theft of Electric energy illegally by way of bypassing meter and nine meter electric wire has been seized and revenue loss amount of Rs. 12,590/- was estimated. On perusal of case record, it further transpires that the accused petitioner

Original of the same has been produced in course of hearing duly compared by the office. Hence, I am inclined to enlarge the accused petitioner namely Mukund Hembram on bail on furnishing bail bond and accordingly, the bail application is hereby allowed. The petitioner namely, Mukund Hembram is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10000/- (Ten Thousand) with one surety of like amount each.
