Heard on the sapurdari application. The report of the concerned police station received, wherein it is submitted that in present FIR No. 157 dated 11.08.2023, u/s 365/323/506/149 IPC, PS City-I, Abohar, vehicle i.e. Activa bearing no. PB-22-S-8416 having engine no. JF50E75215812 and chassis no. ME4JF507GH7215727 is lying in the Police Malkhana, which is in the name of Harjinder Singh son of Kaur Singh, resident of Burj Muhar Colony, Abohar. The police authorities have no objection if the same is given on sapurdari to its original owner.

Upon filing of sapurdari application, notice thereof was issued to the Ld. APP for the State. No formal reply has been submitted by the Ld. APP but he has orally opposed the sapurdari application on the ground that the applicant will alienate the vehicle and the application be dismissed.

3. The present application has been filed by applicant Harjinder Singh son of Kaur Singh by submitting that he is the original owner of above said motorcycle. He has also placed on record photocopy of RC on record as per which Activa in question is in his name. As such, keeping in view the above circumstances and report of the police and documents placed on record, the vehicle in question is ordered to be released on sapurdari to applicant being original owner of vehicle in question, subject to furnishing his sapurdari bonds in the sum of Rs. 55,000/- with the direction not to dispose of, or change its colour, nature and the same will have to be produced in the court on the date when called for. This order is further subject to the condition that if any better claimant came present to court, applicant will have to produce vehicle in question in court for proper order.

4. Sapurdari bonds not furnished. Papers be attached with the main file.
