Today is fixed for production and bail hearing.

Accd. Kailash Roy is produced before this court virtually. He is taken into custody and remanded to J/C.

One bail petition is also filed and moved on behalf of the said accd. person namely, Kailash Roy. Copy served.

Heard. Perused the case record.

Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accd. prays for bail on any terms and condition and submits that the accd. has been lying in custody since 26.04.2026.

It appears that the alleged incident happened on 02.04.2008. Charge sheet was submitted on 31.08.2023 and subsequently, proclamation and attachment was issued and thereafter, on the strength of warrant, he was arrested on 30.04.2026 and since then, he has been in custody. I think as the charge sheet has been submitted long back and also considering the period of detention, the bail prayer of the present accd. petitioner stands allowed. Here, I am also of the considered view that there is no immediate chance of completion of trial.

Accordingly, the present accd. petitioner, Kailash Roy may find **interim bail** (till further order) by furnishing bond of Rs.5000/- with two registered sureties of Rs.2500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. C.J.M, Jalpaiguri along with conditions that the present accd. petitioner shall not leave the territorial jurisdiction of this court and shall attend each and every up-coming dates in court (unless specifically exempted) and not to intimidate the witness whatsoever, failing which, his bail bonds shall stand automatically canceled, I.d to J/C .
