The application for u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the accused-petitioner, namely, Minu Rani Roy, praying for anticipatory bail in connection with Women P.S. Case No.55/2026 dated 09.05.2026 u/s-109/115(2)/85/3(5) of B.N.S., corresponding to PTN No.WBJP02P002687/2026, is taken up for hearing.

Learned Advocate for the accused-petitioner submitted that no bail application filed by the accused-petitioner is either rejected or pending by or before any upper forum including Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta in connection with the instant case.

The bail application filed before this Court by the accused-petitioner also reflect the same and the Ld. Public Prosecutor, Jalpaiguri concedes to such facts.

Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioner submitted that the present accused-petitioner is the old aged mother-in-law of the victim and she has been falsely implicated in this case out of grudge and vendetta. Considering the circumstances, it is prayed that anticipatory bail may be granted to the present accused-petitioner .

On the other hand, Ld. Public Prosecutor, Jalpaiguri raised objection.

Heard both sides.

Perused the materials on record and C.D.

From the materials available before this Court, it appears that investigation in this case has progressed to a considerable extent. The present accused-petitioner is the mother-in-law of the victim. There is allegation in the F.I.R. that the present accused-petitioner along with her son tried to murder her and also inflicted physical torture upon her. But from the F.I.R. it appears that the alleged incident occurred on 29.04.2026 but from the injury report lying in the C.D., it appears that the victim was treated by the doctor on 21.05.2026. Moreover, the injury report shows that the nature of injury is simple.

Considering all the above facts and circumstances, I think that custodial interrogation of the present accused-petitioner is not required for the purpose of investigation and accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail filed on behalf of the above-mentioned accused-petitioner in connection with the above referred case, stands allowed.

Hence, in the event of arrest, the accused-petitioner, namely, Minu Rani Roy be released on furnishing bond of Rs.2,000/- with one (1) surety of like amount, subject to satisfaction of the arresting officer and due compliance with usual provisions as laid down under Sec.482(2) of B.N.S.S.

Let a copy of this order along with T.C.R be sent to the learned C.J.M, Jalpaiguri, for information and taking necessary action.

Return C.D.

Thus, the Criminal Misc. case is disposed of.
