Order No. 05 dated 27.03.2026.

The application for u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the accused-petitioners, namely, 1. Sujata Paul and 2. Anushree Ray, praying for anticipatory bail in connection with Maynaguri P.S. Case No.71/2026 dated 21.02.2026, u/s-108/3(5) of B.N.S., is taken up for hearing.

Learned Advocate for the accused-petitioners submits that no bail application filed by the accused-petitioners is either rejected or pending by or before any upper forum including Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta in connection with the instant case.

The bail application filed before this Court by the accused-petitioners also reflect the same and the Ld. Public Prosecutor, Jalpaiguri concedes to such facts.

Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioners submitted that the present accused-petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case out of misconception. Actually, they are innocent. Accused-petitioners are the permanent residents within the jurisdiction of this court and so, there is no chance of their absconding and they will cooperate with the investigation in all possible way. On all such grounds, it is prayed that anticipatory bail may be granted to the present accused-petitioners.

Defacto complainant appears by filing Vakalatnama and raised objection against the prayer for bail of the accused-petitioners.

Ld. Public Prosecutor, Jalpaiguri also raises objection.

Heard both sides.

Perused the materials on record and C.D.

On perusal of the materials available before this Court, it appears that the victim had a love affairs with accused, one Sujay who is stated to be the principal accused in this case. Allegations against the present accused-petitioners who being the common friends of the deceased victim and the principal accused is that they abetted the the victim in committing suicide. Investigation is still going on and evidences are still forthcoming. Materials so far collected in the C.D. are sufficient for custodial interrogation of the present accused-petitioners . CFSL report in respect of seized mobile is yet to receive.

Considering the present facts and circumstances and materials in the C.D., I find that custodial interrogation or detention of the present accused-petitioners is required in this case.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail filed by the accused-petitioners , namely, 1. Sujata Paul and 2. Anushree Ray stands **rejected**.

Let a copy of this order along with T.C.R be sent to the learned C.J.M, Jalpaiguri, for information and taking necessary action.

Return C.D.

Thus, the Criminal Misc. case is disposed of.
