The application for u/s 483 of B.N.S.S. filed by the accused-petitioner, namely, Bulbul Rahaman, praying for bail in connection with Kotwali P.S. Case No.199/2026 dated 05.05.2026 u/s-126(2)/115(2)/118(2)/109/324(4) of B.N.S. read with Section 25/27 of the Arms Act, is taken up for hearing.

Learned Advocate for the accused-petitioner submitted that no bail application filed by the accused-petitioner is either rejected or pending by or before any upper forum including Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta in connection with the instant case.

The bail application filed before this Court by the accused-petitioner also reflect the same and the Ld. Public Prosecutor, Jalpaiguri concedes to such facts.

Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioner submitted that the accused-petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He is no way connected with the alleged offence as narrated in the written complaint. It is has further been contended that the accused-petitioner is in custody since 28.05.2026 and he will attend the Court on day to day basis, if he is enlarged on bail. On such grounds, it is prayed that bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

On the other hand, Ld. Public Prosecutor, Jalpaiguri, raised vehement objection submitting *inter-alia* that investigation is still going on and the involvement of this accused-petitioner in the alleged offence is sufficiently appearing from the case diary.

Heard both the sides.

Perused the materials on record and C.D.

On perusal of the TCR, CD and on going through the case record it appears that this accused-petitioner is actively involved in the alleged offence. I have carefully perused all the recorded statements under Section 180 of the B.N.S.S. After perusing the same it appears that there is sufficient materials against this accused-petitioner, so far the progress of investigation is concerned and involvement of this accused-petitioner in the alleged occurrence cannot be ruled out. Investigation is still in progress. Considering all the above facts and circumstances and the period of detention, I am not inclined to allow the prayer for bail of this accused-petitioner.

Accordingly, prayer for bail filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner, namely, Bulbul Rahaman, in connection with the above referred case, stands **rejected**, at this stage.

Let a copy of this order along with T.C.R be sent to the learned C.J.M, Jalpaiguri, for information and taking necessary action.

Documents submitted by Ld. Lawyer for the accused-petitioner be kept with the case record.

Thus, the Criminal Misc. case is disposed of.
