

NDPS – 47 of 2018 (45/18)

Record is put up today.

Ld. Lawyer for the accd.1.Dinesh Pandey files a petition for furnishing the bail bonds alongwith the copy of order of CRM(NDPS) 57 of 2023, Dt.07.02.2023 of Hon'ble Calcutta High Court In the Circuit Bench at Jalpaiguri.

As per the order, Honble Court is pleased to direct that “Accordingly, CRM(NDPS) 57 of 2023 is allowed, thereby granting bail to the petitioner,namely, Dinesh Pandey on condition that the petitioner shall furnish bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) , with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court(under NDPS Act), Jalpaiguri subject to the condition that the petitioner further, shall not make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case so as to dissuade such person from disclosing such facts to the court or any police officer or and or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

The petitioner shall not leave the territorial jurisdiction of the trial court during the entire period of trial and shall attend the trial court when the trial commences on each and every date.

Accordingly, the application for bail being CRM(NDPS) 57 of 2023 is disposed of. ”

Perused.

Petitioner may furnish the bail bond.

Since the bail bond register is maintaied by the office of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalpaiguri the accused/petitioner is directed to furnish the bail bond in the office of the Ld. C.J.M., Jalpaiguri in terms of the order of the Hon'ble High Court mentioned above and send the same to this court for acceptance.

Let a copy of this order be sent to the court of Ld. C.J.M., Jalpaiguri for information and taking necessary steps.
